ELECTRIC BILL CHANGE

HEADS UP:

You will see Ohio kWh tax on your electric bills

All Midwest Electric members pay the Ohio kilowatt-hour (kWh) tax as part of your electric rate. It is not a new tax or charge. Previously, it was bundled into other costs on your electric bill, but starting this month, it will be listed as a separate line item for additional transparency.

The Ohio kWh tax (among the highest in the U.S.) is:

- \$0.00465/kWh for the first 2,000 kWh monthly
- \$0.00419/kWh for the next 13,000 kWh monthly
- \$0.00363/kWh for all remaining kWh

Created by the Ohio General Assembly in 2001, the Ohio kWh tax applies to electric distribution companies with end users in Ohio as well as commercial electricity purchasers. It's Midwest Electric's fourth-highest operating expense and costs the average Midwest Electric member \$100 a year through your electric bills.
