Rebate:

- * Insulation rebate to member-consumer is limited to \$200 or 50% of the total project cost (whichever is lower) of a qualifying upgrade project.
- * Air sealing rebate to member-consumer is limited to \$200 or 50% of the total project cost (whichever is lower) of a qualifying upgrade project.

Project Fligibility

- * Program application must be submitted to Midwest Electric by the program deadline each year.
- * All qualifying insulation and air sealing upgrades must be installed in an electrically heated residential home which receives its electric power from Midwest Electric and meet all other requirements of this program.
- * Applicants must own the home and be the homeowner of record. Only one application rebate per area per year is permitted per residence with a lifetime maximum of two areas per home.
- * All projects must be a retrofit installation in an existing residential home. Program is not applicable for new construction or room/home additions or expansions.
- * Rebate is for exterior house, exterior basement or crawlspace walls, attic insulation or air sealing upgrades only. Installations that are NOT ELIGIBLE for a rebate include the following: new construction, new residential additions, garages, sheds, workshops, insulating doors, sound proofing applications, properties with more than two units or product replacement for air sealing (e.g. replacing doors, windows, lighting fixtures, etc.).
- * For insulation rebate, contractor must follow ENERGY STAR guidelines and achieve minimums as indicated in form above.
- * Insulation and air sealing upgrades must be installed by a licensed contractor. Do-it-yourself insulation and air sealing upgrade projects are not eligible for this rebate.
- * All projects must comply with applicable federal, state and local laws and building codes.

Documentation

- * A blower door test is required for all air sealing projects. Final test results after air sealing upgrade must achieve < 4,000 CFM50 to be eligible for rebate.
- * A duct blast test is required for all duct sealing upgrades. Final test results after duct sealing must achieve ≤ 12CFM25 per 100 sq. ft. to be eligible for rebate.
- * All applications must be complete and include an itemized contractor invoice detailing cost breakout for each area of work/improvement made in order to be considered. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

Installation Verification

The cooperative reserves the right to inspect member home for installation of materials listed on this application to verify that installation meets program guidelines.
